The Fire Marshals Association of Colorado is once again offering this highly popular program designed to provide participants with assistance in their preparation for the IFC certification examination at the Inspector I and II levels. Instructors are fire code officials from Colorado fire departments.

- **Codes and References:** Participants shall be responsible for providing their own code books. Practice test and presentation slides will be given in an electronic format. Participants are encouraged to bring a laptop or print out the material before each class. This program will use the 2018 IFC/IBC and related references as required by ICC.
- **Certification Test:** Examinations are now administered electronically via computer-aided testing. Exams are administered for ICC by Promissor, a professional test administration company. ## IFC Inspector Certifications

### Fire Code Inspector I

The Fire Inspector I Certification demonstrates satisfactory knowledge of the relevant provisions of the International Fire Code in the inspection and evaluation of new and existing fire-prevention, fire detection and fire-control measures, and other related life-safety provisions for compliance with the International Fire Code.

The scope of certification follows Fire Inspector I standards as specified in NFPA 1031—*Professional Qualifications for Fire Inspector and Plan Examiner*.

#### Certification References:

- **2018 International Fire Code (ICC), including Appendix B**
- **2018 International Building Code (ICC), specifically Chapter 2, 4, 6 and 7\***
- **Fire Inspection and Code Enforcement, 6th Edition (IFSTA)**

*(Many have found this reference to be optional for Inspector I Certification. Certification references are based on the current Candidate Bulletin and are subject to change.)*

### Fire Code Inspector II

Fire Code Inspector II Certification demonstrates satisfactory knowledge of the relevant provisions of the IFC in the inspection and evaluation of new and existing fire-prevention, fire detection and fire-control measures, and other related life-safety provisions for compliance with the IFC.

The scope of this certification follows Fire Inspector II standards specified by NFPA 1031, *Professional Qualifications for Fire Inspector and Plan Examiner*. This examination includes some plan reading questions. Fire Code Inspector I Certification is a

mandatory prerequisite to be certified as a Fire Inspector II per ICC requirements.

- **Fire Inspection and Code Enforcement, 6th Edition (IFSTA)**

This program is intended to familiarize individuals with the International Fire Code. It does not “teach to the code”. Participants seeking certification should plan additional self-study.
