Position Description:

Responsible for the management and coordination of community risk reduction and life safety programs including public education and engagement; assist with the administration of policies pertaining to code inspection and enforcement; special permit issuance; plan review, inspection and records management as the Fire Code Official for new construction and existing businesses; assist in fire investigations and Engine Company referrals and inquiries in coordination with District, Town, County, and/or State offices relative to code enforcement activities within the Eaton Fire Protection District. The Fire Inspector reports directly to the Fire Chief. Position is "at-will" and not specified by contractual agreement, and will comply with all orders, guidelines, and policies as defined in the Employee Handbook of the Eaton Fire Protection District.

Essential Job Functions:

- Manages, plans and coordinates with the Fire Chief all fire prevention, education, plan review and inspection, investigation and community engagement activities; including supervising subordinate personnel assigned to program duties.
- Maintains a close working relationship with internal and external stakeholders.
- Coordinates inspections, re-inspections and follow-ups in commercial, educational, assembly, industrial and other assigned occupancies.
- Coordinates the District's special permitting programs including Hazmat, Fireworks and the like.



- Reviews and enforces the current adopted District fire code for all new construction plan reviews requested within the District boundaries and others as assigned. Attends development review, planning and land use meetings as needed.
- Coordinates fire code adoption with the Town of Eaton and Weld County.
- Plans, develops and implements public education and community risk reduction programs.
- Develops and maintains SOPs/SOGs as needed, pertaining to the Fire Prevention Division.
- Participates in the EFPD Command Team monthly meetings and activities.
- Manages required continuing education to satisfy the renewal of all certifications possessed.
- Assists with fire investigations.
- Gains and maintains a solid knowledge of target hazards within the District to help with the creation and management of pre-plans.
- Participates, when available, in on-duty training and safety programs as conducted or provided by the District as a member of the command staff.
- Must promote, support, and enforce all policies, guidelines, and directives of the Eaton Fire Protection District, the Town of Eaton, Weld County, State of Colorado and Federal laws.
- Must maintain a valid Colorado driver's license and an acceptable MVR and be approved to operate department vehicles by the departments Insurance carrier.
- Must exhibit a professional demeanor to the public and within the department at all times

Supervisory Duties:

• Position functions may require the indirect supervision of other members.

Working Environment:

- This position requires performing job functions and training in a variety of locations to include but not limited to, office, construction sites, industrial facilities and other public places. Conditions include work inside and out of doors in all weather conditions including extreme temperatures, and sometimes on emergency scenes.
- Emergency scenes, working environments and training scenarios may include but are not limited to operating from height, on roadways, on uneven and slick surfaces, and environments of limited mobility or confined spaces and unstable or structures.
- Work may result in the exposure to hazardous environments and contaminated areas which may result in potential harm or injury including exposure to electrical currents, high noise levels, mechanical equipment, hazardous materials, toxic substances, carcinogens, radiation and other environments immediately dangerous to life and health. Work may also result in the exposure to infectious diseases or illnesses and blood borne pathogens.
- Occasionally required to travel and represent the Eaton Fire Protection District at meetings, seminars, trainings, and public gatherings.

Physical Requirements:

- Must be able to wear required personal protective equipment and self-contained breathing apparatus, independent of other members, without exhibiting claustrophobic tendencies.
- Work includes emergency and non-emergency situations that may be intermittently
 physically and emotionally stressful. Frequently work includes a combination of
 sedentary and highly physical demanding periods. Moderate lifting and carrying;
 constantly items up to 10lbs, frequent 10-25lbs and occasional heavy lifting of items
 greater than 50lbs is required. Work includes aerobic capacity, flexibility, equilibrium and
 anaerobic power to lift and carry, sit, stand, walk, pull, push, crawl, bend, kneel and
 climb for long periods of time and in a variety of working environments.
- Must have good vision, hearing and the ability to smell and identifying items by touch and communicate sensory activities through speech.
